Immunizations

PLEASE NOTE: Students will not be allowed to attend school until proof of current immunizations and PPD is given to the school office before the first day of school, August 19, 2008.

Check your health records to make sure your children have received all their immunizations.

Alaska Law **REQUIRES** all children to be immunized against polio, diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough, measles and rubella in order to attend Alaska schools. Verification that a child is appropriately immunized must be medically certified and show the date of each dose of vaccine. Provisions are available for medical and religious exceptions.

The State of Alaska requires that your child have a PPD test for tuberculosis between the dates of May 21, 2007 – August 19, 2008 (within 90 days prior to the first day of school) to be admitted to ICS or Monroe for the 2008-2009 school year. This applies to all Kindergarten and 7th grade students (new and returning) and students of all grade levels who have not attended ICS or Monroe previously.

It is your responsibility to have your child immunized and to provide this school with a medically verified record for all required immunizations he/she has received. If your child needs an immunization, please contact your private physician or the Fairbanks Regional Public Health Center.

10 Year Booster	DT Booster is due 10 years after the initial series is complete	
Not Valid Before 2 nd Birthday	Hep. A (Initial Dose; 2 nd Dose 6 months after #1)	
	Hep. B (Initial Dose; 2 nd Dose 1 month after #1; 3 rd Dose 6 months after #1 or 5 months after #2)
