- Why are there fundraisers if families pay tuition?
 - Tuition only covers about 65% of the schools' operating expenses.
 - Help us increase enrollment! Share your positive experiences of the Catholic Schools of Fairbanks with your friends and family.
 - The remaining \$1,400,000 must be raised by fundraising.
 - The Spring Matching Fundraiser and HIPOW are the two main fundraisers for the Catholic Schools of Fairbanks.
- What do funds from the Spring Matching Fundraiser do?
 - Funds donated in the Spring Matching Fundraiser cover operating expenses like classroom supplies and teacher salaries for the Catholic Schools of Fairbanks. As mentioned above, tuition only covers about 65% of those costs.
- Didn't you just have a fundraiser this Spring?
 - Yes, the Finish Line! This campaign raised over \$160,000 to complete our gym renovations.

- This was an amazing effort; we are humbled and grateful for our community for their help. The money raised will go entirely to finishing our gym.
 - This means that we still need our additional fundraisers, like the Spring Fundraiser, to offset our standard operating expenses.

All donations will be doubled. Thanks to the generosity of Skip and Linda Johnson, Bert and Becky Bell, Judi and Mike Grahek, Jim and Sandra Haselberger, the Ken Lund Trust, Cheryl and Rick Schikora, and the Jesuits West, your donation will be doubled up to \$75,000. \$25 will become \$50, \$50 will become \$100, and \$100 becomes \$200. It's another opportunity for us to truly celebrate our strength and resilience while ensuring the mission continues.
